



GRANTS PROGRAM

The Kay Stafford Memorial Fund will, at least semi-annually, award funds with the aim of assisting charitable health and support agencies and the public, in order to improve health services and the health delivery system within QH Trenton Memorial catchment area.

The Kay Stafford Memorial Fund will award disbursements in the following two (2) categories:

1. Education

The Kay Stafford Memorial Fund will undertake Trenton Memorial staff educational programs and the development of educational resources to assist health care providers in improving the management of change in health care. The objective of educational programs will be to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of health care services and the health care delivery system. A maximum of 25% of income available each year will be made available by the Foundation for staff education, providing that there are proposals.

2. Community Health Care Programs

Award monies will also be granted to health care programs that significantly contribute to the health status of Quinte West area residents. The Kay Stafford Memorial Fund will endeavour to support both community health care programs that have existed and continue to provide health services, while providing grants to new and innovative health care projects that will benefit our community. An annual review will be made to the Foundation Board to re-evaluate the purpose of the funds.

A complete application in both the first and second category of Grants must be undertaken by the recipients and submitted to the Trenton Memorial Hospital Foundation Board of Directors for evaluation.
